### *Dornier*

The Dornier Donatus 2004 carries a bouquet of dark, rich fruits and delicate violet. The palate is silky with refined tannins and a mineral character, and an elegant lingering aftertaste completes the wine-drinking enjoyment. The Donatus pairs well with seared venison loin on coriander and cumin-flavoured cassoulet with a jus reduction, and retails at an average of R155.



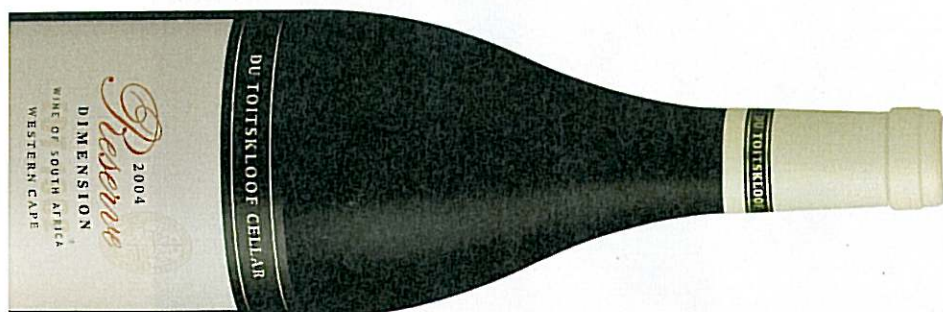
### *Laborie*

The Laborie Cap Classique Blanc de Blanc is a delicious sparkling wine ideal for spring. Aromas of creamy biscuit, citrus and melon are followed by a fresh citrusy mouth which carry the aromas through. Shellfish, seafood, fruit or dessert are the perfect companions to the bubbly, or it can be enjoyed on its own. The average retail price is R65.



### *Du Toitskloof*

The Du Toitskloof Dimension Reserve 2004 carries a lovely pomegranate colour, behind which lies a bouquet of berries and chocolate. This carries through beautifully onto the palate, with firm, dry tannins closing the deal. Pairing well with red meat, curry and breads, the Reserve retails for an average of R63.



### *Drostdy-Hof*

The Chatt' Box Witty White Off-dry white wine in a cool and handy re-sealable box is perfect for picnics or outdoor enjoyment. The white gold colour with a nose of fruity greens leads onto a palate of exotic fruit flavours. Pairing well with poultry, fish and salads, the wine retails at an average of R19.99.
